Medication Description: Contraceptives lower the risk of becoming pregnant primarily by suppressing ovulation. Other possible mechanisms may include cervical mucus changes that inhibit sperm penetration and endometrial changes that reduce the likelihood of implantation.

Covered Uses: Oral Contraceptives are FDA approved for the prevention of pregnancy.
