



**Drugs Excluded from Mail Order Dispensing**

Your ConnectiCare prescription drug benefit includes a mail service benefit using Express Scripts Mail Service Pharmacy. The mail service pharmacy fills prescriptions for long-term conditions such as asthma, diabetes, high cholesterol and hypertension. Schedule II narcotics, certain injectable drugs and some drugs that are part of the quality management drug program (quantity limit) are not appropriate to be filled on an extended basis and therefore are excluded from the mail order program. In addition, drugs that are listed in our Specialty Drug Program are limited to 30 day fills at designated specialty pharmacies. This information can also be found in your Prescription Drug Rider membership agreement.

**The following drugs CAN NOT be filled through Express Scripts Mail Service Pharmacy:**
