MOST RECENT ASSESSMENT AND PLAN		
ASSESSMENT Frail 58yo man with multiple myeloma, with ESRD on HD, recent hospitalization at Spectrum Health Blodgett Hospital for pain crisis, sepsis. Critically ill during hospitalization, where he was intubated in the emergency room and given vasopressors to stabilize his blood pressure. Now stable but weaker, beginning attempt at home PT/OT. His biggest symptom issue is uncontrolled pain, especially during and after dialysis.		
PATIENT MANAGEMENT PLAN Advance Care Planning: Addressed long term planning with daughter at patient's request. Based on recent hospitalization and full understanding of the situation, we changed code status to DNR/DNI. POST completed, on refrigerator. Family instructed to call Aspire if his condition changes. Oncology: Discussed with Dr. Gregory House (oncologist). He will determine plan for restarting Velcade therapy or alternative chemotherapy, and consider hospice enrollment if patient condition worsens further. Pain: Will start Fentanyl 12 mcg patch q 72 hrs with oxycodone 5mg for breakthrough pain q 4hrs, with plan for slow titration upwards of his patch if he tolerates the medicine. He remains on renal -dose gabapentin for neuropathic pain, possibly secondary to myeloma or Velcade.
